



## 2011 AGRA RV Park Information

Welcome Back! We are again offering a weekend package for the RV Park and entry into the rodeo.

### **Pricing for the AGRA RV Park stay:**

- Tents are \$5.00 per night, per tent. Limit of 4 People. (Additional people in your party are \$5.00 per person – NO ELECTRIC Available for Tent campers. Tents are allowed at RV sites but they still incur a separate fee for the tent and extra people staying in it.)
- Thursday night: \$25.00 (single space up to 4 people. Any additional people in your party are \$5.00 per person. No electric available Thursday night at this time.)
- Friday and Saturday night stay, including entry into the rodeo both days for 2 people, including a single RV space: \$100.00
- Additional people in your party must purchase their rodeo tickets through the website or at the rodeo grounds and are \$5.00 per person per night when staying in the RV PARK.
- Sunday night: \$25 (Single space up to 4 people. Any additional people in your party are \$5.00 per person.)

There is a separate section on the blacktop adjacent to the pavilion facility and RV Park lawn area that is available for use this year (south side). Anyone interested in dry camping in this area, for the weekend will be charged \$10.00 per night with a limit of 4. Any additional people in your party are \$5.00 per person per night. (NO WATER, ELECTRIC, OR DUMPING)

(The above prices do not include the Friday night dinner, drinks or any meals offered at the Rawhide facility or at any Rawhide restaurant or food and beverage vendor supplied by the Rodeo Association)

(The prices above include electricity for RV's only – See section "Rules and Guidelines" for specific information on generator and electric times and availability)

Contestants and Vendors needing RV space must contact the RV Park Director directly, and must have prior approval from the Rodeo Director. There is a charge for space in the RV Park, and you are not guaranteed electricity.



### Rules and Guidelines for the AGRA RV Park

- All RV Park fees must be paid in advance through the Rodeo website, [agra-phx.com](http://agra-phx.com), or upon arrival at the Rawhide facility. RV Park Reservation receipts must be provided when checking in at Rawhide if you paid through the website. Anyone checking into the RV Park must check in with the RV Park Director or the Assistant RV Park Director. **Any fees paid upon arrival at the Rawhide facility that apply to the RV PARK must be paid to the RV Park Director – Jason Delto.** Receipts will be available upon request.
- Campers can begin checking in as early as Thursday before rodeo weekend at 12 noon...NO EARLIER!! All campers must vacate the Rawhide facility no later than Monday at 12 noon.
- Campers must camp in marked spaces as instructed by the RV Park Director. All extra or tow vehicles must fit in your assigned space, and/or comply with all fire lane restrictions according to the International Fire Code, and/or as directed by Rawhide, Rodeo, or RV PARK personnel.
- All spaces are on a FIRST COME...FIRST SERVED BASIS...The earlier you get there, the better your chances of getting the spot you want.
- Electric is provided for the first 50 spaces. **Paying in advance** is the only way to guarantee a site with electric is available upon your arrival. (Should we get more than 50 reservations for electric, more electric equipped spaces may be provided.) As some of the electric pods can be some distance from your rig, be sure to bring whatever you need to plug in. Cables and adapters from 50amp down to 110vac or any combination of availability in between will not be provided. **(We currently do not have definitive information on what type of receptacle will be provided.)**
- If it is determined that your rig is overloading, drawing too much power, or blowing circuits, you will be asked to unplug. No refunds will be given for this contingency.
- Electricity, as in the past is provided by generator. In order to offset the fuel cost we will again have limited hours. The hours of operation are as follows:
  - 06:00 (6am) to 10:00 (10am)
  - 16:00 (4pm) to 23:00 (11pm)
- Electricity will be available starting Friday afternoon through Sunday night.
- NO ONE is allowed to plug into the Rawhide Facility power receptacles without specific permission.



- Should you wish to bring your own generator to run in the off hours, feel free to do so, but please be respectful of those camped around you and abide by the quiet hours of 22:00 (10pm) to 08:00 (8am).
- There are NO water hookups available. Bring what you need.
- There is **NO DUMPING** of GRAY and/or BLACKWATER either on the ground or in storm drains.
- Trash must be placed in proper trash bags or trash receptacles.
- Alcoholic beverages are allowed in the RV Park but must remain there. They are not to be taken to any other part of the facility. Only those 21 years and older are allowed to possess, or consume alcoholic beverages of any kind, at any time anywhere on the Rawhide facility, Rodeo grounds, or RV Park.
- Campers are encouraged to decorate their rigs and camp sites, but are reminded to be tasteful with the decorations. Any items deemed inappropriate will require the item(s) immediate removal.
- All campers are required to dress appropriately, no nudity, or clothing of an explicit or sexual nature is allowed...This is a FAMILY event.
- Dog's are allowed in the RV Park but must remain on a leash at all times. Dog's are to stay in the RV Park and are the owner's responsibility. Owners are responsible for picking up after their pets. Other people don't want to step in it any more than you do. Anyone not doing so will be asked to leave and/or remove the animal from the premises. All dogs must have a current license that meets with the standards of Maricopa and/or Pinal Counties in Arizona.
- Fires are allowed as long as the local county does not have a burn day restriction in place.
- **Fires can only be burned in an acceptable, approved, above ground containers.**
- **No ground fires Allowed.**
- **No Fire pits or BBQ grills allowed on the grass area.**
- **No Bonfires or fires that are burning higher than 2.5 feet above the bottom of the fire pit.** Anyone seen burning a fire deemed consistently out of control, will be told to put it out.
- **You must have a fire extinguisher readily available.**
- **Please be responsible.**



- Please ask the RV Park Director should you have any questions regarding rules for fires, or fire containment.
- There are **NO FIREARMS or FIREWORKS ALLOWED!!** The Rawhide facility and Rodeo RV Park are located on **Gila River Indian community land**. All laws, rules, and requests of the Indian Community must be adhered to, no exceptions. You are responsible for any laws broken while on Indian land, the Rodeo Association and its sponsors or associates will not be held responsible for your mistakes or the mistakes of the irresponsible.
