



2012 RRRR Vendor Invitation



The Arizona Gay Rodeo Association would like to invite you to be a part of the 27th Annual RoadRunner Regional Rodeo to be held on February 17-19, 2012 at Rawhide at Wild Horse Pass on the Gila River Indian Community, 5700 W. North Loop Rd., Chandler, AZ 85226.

We ask that all applicants please read the information below, as some items may have changed. Please fill out and return the Contract and Application forms with applicable payment.

All vendor spaces will be reserved on a **FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS**.

Vendors are responsible for set-up and tear down.

Vendors are responsible for their own lighting and extension cords.

Two chairs will be provided with each rental space for the weekend. Tables will not be provided but may be rented for \$10.00 each or you may supply your own. Additional chairs may be rented for \$5.00 each.

Tables and chairs **must** be ordered on the application to confirm quantities.

No firearms are permitted on the rodeo grounds.

No smoking permitted in the pavilion.

No pets are permitted on the rodeo grounds

Each vendor space is 10'x10' and all spaces are inside the Rawhide Pavilion.

In consideration of the additional special public events to be held in and out of the pavilion on Friday evening, and to give our vendors the opportunity for increased exposure and revenue, set-up will begin on Friday, February 17, 2012 at 8:00 am and must be completed by Friday, February 17, 2012 at 6:00 pm.

Sales may begin at 6:00 pm on Friday and at 8:00 am on Saturday and Sunday and continue until all activities end in the pavilion.

ALL VENDORS MUST KEEP THEIR BOOTHS OPEN UNTIL 6:00 PM ON SUNDAY. TEAR DOWN MAY BEGIN AT 6:00 PM ON SUNDAY.

ALL MERCHANDISE, EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE PAVILION BY 11:59 PM ON SUNDAY.

NO FOOD OR BEVERAGE SALES WILL BE ALLOWED.

Sales and/or solicitation are restricted to your assigned vendor space.

Vendors must complete and return the Vendor Application and Vendor Contract with a **check, money order or cashier's check**, payable to AGRA. Each organization selling anything must also complete the Gila River Indian Community Business License Application and remit a \$30.00 check, money order or cashier's check, payable to the Gila River Indian Community, to obtain a license. Please return ALL forms to: Vendors c/o AGRA P.O. Box 40465 Phoenix, AZ 85067-0465 as soon as possible to guarantee your space(s). **Vendor spaces will not be reserved until all forms and payments are received.**
